Summary: The Elementary Program Coordinator plans, implements and oversees the operational success of elementary age programs offered by The Canby Center (TCC), at TCC and via School District partnerships. The ideal candidate will be volunteer-centric, responsible and focused, with outstanding organizational skills, a strong communicator with a high level of effectiveness in serving elementary youth and families.

- Oversee day-to-day operations of Reading Mentors, Tutoring and Backpack Buddies programs
- Maintain a high level of TCC mission alignment in elementary programs with centrality to TCC values of faith, community, and dignity, in speech and in action.
- Proactively collaborate with TCC staff in accomplishing individual and team goals
- Recruit, screen, train and manage volunteer teams in program delivery
- Cultivate strong relationships with the Canby School District, school leaders and relevant partner agencies
